## Safe System Analytics

## What is Safe System Analytics?

Safe System Analytics (SSA) is a Microsoft Power BI application, which provides downloadable crash statistics and data visualisations together in one location.

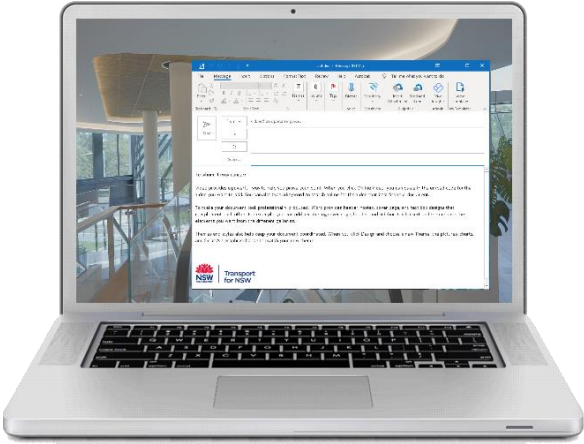
A SSA Council app has been developed for council users, providing details of crashes by local government area and reporting time period. Reports include summary and detailed crash reports, crash and casualty comparisons between local government areas and regions, and crash maps that show the locations of crashes.

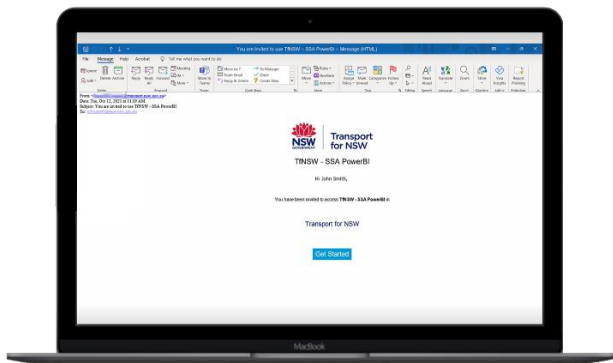
Reports on this site contain crash data that conforms to the 1983 national guidelines for reporting and classifying road vehicle crashes.

The main criteria are:

- The crash was reported to the police
- The crash occurred on a road open to the public
- The crash involved at least one moving road vehicle
- The crash involved at least one person being killed or injured or at least one motor vehicle being towed away.

**Below you will find instructions on how to access the SSA app.**

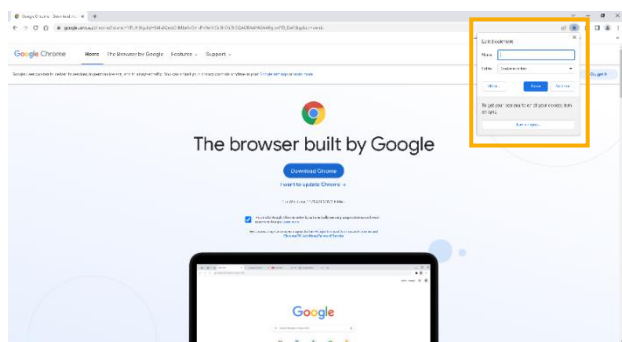

2. You will receive an email with the link to the app.

Generic email addresses cannot be used to login. You need to access the app via your Microsoft account. If you don't have one, you will be asked to create one.

You'll be asked to authenticate yourself using the Microsoft Authenticator app or SMS.



3. We recommend using Google Chrome to launch the app.

You can add a bookmark using the browser. This will make it easier to access the system.



4. Follow the on-screen instructions until you see the homepage.

5. On the SSA Council homepage, you will see the SSA Council Portal logo. The homepage contains
  - A navigation panel on the left of the screen
  - Nine quick access tiles that provide quick links to reports and other information
  - A 'Notices' section that provides updates and news
