Step 2:

Work out a project strategy involving road safety partners

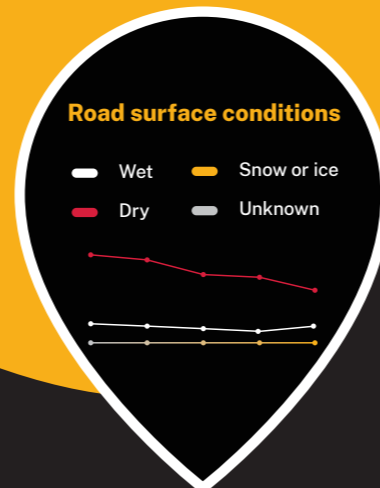
Identify road safety partners. Form a team who you'll work together with to save lives.



Step 3:

Identify key road safety issues using road crash data

Use the local road data available and conduct an assessment.



Step 4:

Consult and obtain council support

Gain support for the strategy and secure council commitment.



Step 5:

Design your Local Road Safety Strategic Plan and establish your actions

Identify how to implement and communicate your actions, and determine how the project will be evaluated.
